Setup & Operating Procedure

Before operating the Master Groomer it must be setup to groom synthetic turf fields in the manner it was intended. The Master Groomer is **not** setup directly from the factory; **do not** use it unless the steps below have been followed. Using the groomer directly after reaching its final destination, without set up, will display poor results and not perform in the manner it was intended to. It has been setup this way for shipping purposes only (transport mode).

Listed below are the steps one should follow in order to setup the groomer to the default position. From there, it may be adjusted based on operator's preference.

Default position

- I. With the tow bar attached to the vehicle towing the Master Groomer, move the groomer on to the field/turf.
- II. Adjust the front brush so that there are 3 ¹/₂ dimples showing on the Screw Jack
- III. Adjust the "W" brush (second tool from the front), along with the rear brush, with 3 dimples showing on the screw jack
- IV. Start the vehicle that is towing the Master Groomer and pull it forward to test the grooming pattern. What to look out for is an even spread and covering of the infill throughout the 6 feet width. Along with this, check to see if the turf fibres are stood upright, thus creating a grain pattern.

At this time any adjustments that need to be made should be done now. Adjustments should be done in 1 or 2 turn intervals. Adjusting may also be done to the nearest dimple, if turns are insufficient. Once satisfied with the setup, groom away! Be sure to groom in opposite directions along the length of the field. Doing so will display an opposing grain pattern throughout the course of the field.

Prior to leaving the field, raise all three tools to their highest positions. This is the **transport mode**. The wheels will always stay the same for both transport mode and default mode. Move the Master Groomer off the field on to a hard surface, where cleaning of the machine or tools of excess infill can be done.

Helpful tips

- Minor adjustments may be required after each use
- A recommended speed of operations is 3-5 MPH (5-8 KPH)
- Avoid a "hop" action when grooming
- Reverse brush sections once or twice a year to correct the bristle bending action (this will extend the life of the brushes)

Maintenance

The following maintenance requirements should be performed **before** each use of the Master Groomer.

- Grease the tow pins prior to attaching the groomer to the tractor (allows for easy attaching/detaching)
- Grease the screw jacks via the grease fittings located on the top and side of the screw jacks (there are **2** fittings per screw jack)
- Grease the wheel bearings via the grease fitting located on the back of wheel hub

Please view the parts break down if you are unsure of the locations for the grease fittings listed


